

# BOUNCY CASTLE SETUP

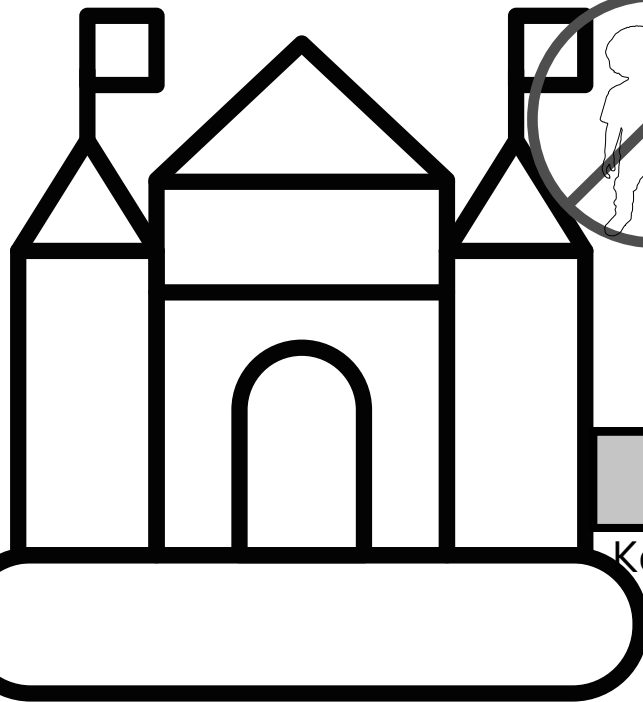


Do not use in wet or windy conditions



Do not use near trees or power lines.

Keep 1m clear from structures - Walls, fences, trees etc.



Keep children away from electrics. Do not let them hang from walls of BC.

Securely peg down bouncy castle



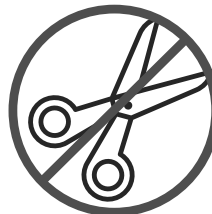
Keep tube straight and secured

Use provided tarpaulin underneath to prevent friction

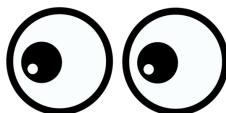
Use castle on flat, smooth, clean area so it can be pegged down and there is no risk of tears, staining or other damage from surface.



Do not have things that can stain the vinyl on or near bouncy castle: Streamers, silly string, poppers, wet face paint (ensure dry).



No shoes, sharp things, smoking, food or drink near or on bouncy castle



Adult 18+ supervision at all times

# PACK UP CHECKLIST

- Bouncy castle is swept and free of debris.
- Any dirty marks are cleaned with soapy water.
- Bouncy castle is dry.
- When folding up the castle have the bouncing area, walls and spires on the inside and the underneath/base on the outside.
- Fold up castle in thirds and fold up towards air vent/outlet to force air out.
- Tarpaulin is dry.
- If tarpaulin is wet underneath, fold it up length-by-length, drying with a towel as you go.
- Wrap up extension cord neatly but loosley.
- Report any incidents to the Bouncy Castle Coordinator
- Report any equipment issues to the Bouncy Castle Coordinator: Rips, holes, wear, mould, damage,
- Equipment is clean and neatly packed into two bags:
  1. Bouncy Castle
  2. Pegs, tarpaulin, extension cord, blower, instructions.
